## **Fabric**

- 100% cotton fabric – approximately one yard total. Ball may be stitched on a single color of fabric or multiple colors of fabric

## **Threads**

- A variety of threads may be used; DMC, Anchor, silk, metallic
- Coordinating sewing thread

## **Beads – Mill Hill**

- 3 packages of size 11 seed beads
- 2 packages of Small Bugle Beads
- 3 packages of Medium Bugle beads

## **Miscellaneous**

- Sheer weight interfacing
- 3 or 4 sheets of Sticky Fabri-Solvy™– This product is generally available at quilt shops. It comes in a package of 12 sheets and students may wish to share. Some shops may also offer it in single sheets.
- Heavy Duty Template Plastic by Dritz. This is optional.
- Stuffing – either Sweet Dreams Cotton Stuffing or Polyester Fiberfill
- Needles – size 9, 10, or 11 Sharps, and/or size 9 or 10 Embroidery needles, and size 10 Betweens for attaching beads.
- 6" and 4" embroidery hoops
