Read Lesson 1 before buying any materials. Items in blue were used on the model.

Fabric and Support

- 8" x 10" linen of chosen count in white, off-white, cream, or ivory. **Model is 28 count.**
- 8" x 10" stretcher bars and tacks or staples with which to attach the linen

Polychrome Thread Supplies

- Sewing thread, neutral color
- Scissors for fiber threads – do not use the same pair that you use for metal threads
- Choose all threads from one column; quantities are estimates. Alternate colors are in parentheses.

- 1 lump of beeswax
- Scissors for metal thread
- Choose one column of Passing thread, the lizerine, & spangles if you wish.

Doodle Materials

- Doodle cloth: 14 or 18-count canvas or plastic canvas
- Cotton braiding cord (see Fig. O-1) or perle cotton 5
- Yarn darner or similar large needle

Needles

- For floss and sewing thread
 - Tapestry needle, size 26 or 28
 - Milliner's needle size 10
- For metal passing threads
 - Tapestry needle, size 22 or 24
 - Chenille needle, size 22 or 24

Optional Tools

- hedebo stick
- laying tool or tekobari (for flat silk)
- mellore
- tweezers
- toothpick
- seam-binding or tape
- small sponge (for flat silk)
- magnifier, particularly for Lesson 6

Design Transfer Materials

- design on tracing paper
- ground fabric
- ruler

Modern Method

- a fine-line pen that gives a sharp, permanent black line
- a pencil
- a lightbox or window
- artist's or painter's low-tack tape

Historical Method

- pricking tool: either a tracing wheel or a needle
- straight pins
- black pounce (charcoal)
- a small muslin bag for pounce
- fine brush
- black ink or paint
