Casalguidi Floral Trellis or Golden Gate Bridge (see cover): four-sided stitch, padded raised stem band, long curl stitch and buttonhole bobbles. Prework of four-sided stitch.



Silk Ribbon Butterfly Ring

Silk Ribbon Butterfly Ring stitch, spider web stitch, French knots, woven picot, gathering stitch, lazy daisy stitch and plume stitch
