**MATERIAL LIST**

❖ **Finished size approximately 7" x 7" (18cm x 18cm)**

**MATERIALS NEEDED**

- ❖ 1 piece of #32ct Belfast linen (Confederate gray) - 11" x 11" (28cm x 28cm)
- ❖ 1 piece of #32ct Belfast linen (Confederate gray) - 11" x 13" (28cm x 33cm)
- ❖ 1 ball DMC® #8 Coton Perlé ~ colour #927
- ❖ 10 yards (9.1m) DMC® #8 Perlé Coton ~ colours #928 and 926
- ❖ 2 skeins DMC® floss ~ colour #927
- ❖ Basting thread

**FINISHING MATERIALS NEEDED**

- ❖ 1 piece of silk lining, colour coordinated to linen, cut 9" x 20" (23cm x 51cm)
- ❖ Mat boards cut – one 7" x 7" (17.8cm x 17.8cm), two 7" x 3½" (17.8cm x 8.9cm)
- ❖ slightly thinner board cut – one 6 7/8" x 6 7/8" (17.5cm x 17.5cm), two 6 7/8" x 3 7/16" (17.5cm x 8.75cm)
- ❖ Sewing thread the colour of the lining
- ❖ 10'(feet) (3m (metres)) of double back tape
- ❖ 1½" (4cm) piece of card

**EQUIPMENT NEEDED**

- ❖ Extra fine water erasable marker
- ❖ Small piece of tracing paper
- ❖ #24 tapestry needle
- ❖ #24 chenille or #7 embroidery (sharp) needle
- ❖ Milliners needle (optional)
- ❖ Sharp fine point embroidery scissors
- ❖ 5" (12.5cm) wooden hoop
- ❖ Needle nabber (½ a rubber band from broccoli is good!)
- ❖ 2 C clamps or mini Gripits
- ❖ Light and/or magnifier if you use one
- ❖ Small white hand towel

**NOTE:**

- *The small clean white hand towel placed over your lap (knees) while stitching this piece will help to keep your embroidery free of dark threads and animal hair/fur that can transfer from your clothes to the thread or linen and get caught in the stitching.*
