Supply List

- 15" x 18" piece of DMC or Charles Craft 28 count linen in each of main color (MC) main color # B5200 white and color A #842
- 4 skeins DMC floss in: Color A #3782 Mocha Brown-light
- 1 skein DMC floss for the Roses: #3607, #3608, #3609, #3689, #23, #818, #819, #3363, #3364
- 1 skein DMC floss for the Lavender: #3362, #24, #341, #340
- 1 skein DMC floss for the Plum Flowers: #3011, #3012, #554, #553
- 1 skein DMC floss for the Fuchsia Sprig: #469, #35
- Needles: Embroidery needle sizes 7 and 9, Milliners/Straw needle size 5 or 7, Tapestry Needle 24
- 1 piece of buckram at least 3" x 48" [Sample was made using Pellon #376 Fusible Buckram (100 % cotton) measuring 20" x 54"]
- 1 piece (at least 15" x 18") of lightweight interfacing or lightweight white cotton fabric (preferably not too tightly woven) to back the linen fabric under the textured embroidery section
- Sewing thread to match color A fabric
- 2 strap swivel hooks (Sample was made using two packages of Dritz #728-38 Small Swivel hook and D –Ring ½ inch.)
- Fabric marker or marking pencil to mark placement for embroidery design
- Usual stitching supplies including tape measure or ruler, (optional) embroidery hoop, embroidery scissors, fabric scissors and (optional) straight pins (preferably with larger heads so that they don't "disappear" into the linen.

Please note that the stitcher can choose a different color linen – if so, the floss needed as Color A should coordinate with the linen color. In addition, the stitcher can certainly change any or all of the flower colors. The fabric and floss colors indicated were used by Pat.
