### **Fabric**

- 28-count Linen—18” x 27” (fat quarter) in Wichelt Christmas Red Linen or Wichelt Natural Brown Linen or Cashel Cream Linen
- Solid 100% cotton fabric to match linen—10” x 18” or a fat quarter
- Coordinating 100% cotton print fabric—4” x 7”
- Coordinating felted wool, Red—4” x 11”
- 100% wool felt—White—3” x 3”
- Warm and White Cotton Batting—6” x 8” piece
- Peltex 71F, single-sided fusible, ultra firm stabilizer—4” x 6”

### **Thread**

- Anchor #1206—Candy Apple, variegated—5 skeins
- Anchor #47 Carmine Red—1 skein
- Kreinik Very Fine (#4) Braid, Color #003 Red—1 spool

### **Miscellaneous**

- Needles—size 26 Tapestry, 28 Tapestry or #10 Sharp (for attaching beads),
- 11° Mill Hill Antique Glass Beads—#03049 Rich Red—2 packages (5.26 grams)
- 1/8” Ribbon—red to coordinate—for pinkeep—12” piece
- Glass-headed pins to coordinate—for pinkeep
- Dritz Heavy-duty Template Plastic—6” x 8” piece

### **Finishing Supplies and Tools**

- Stitchery Tape from Specialty Tapes (available from Yarn Tree)
- Fray-Stop (available from Yarn Tree)
- Brush—small, 1/4” flat watercolor brush or similar (for applying Fray-Stop)
- Aleene’s Tacky Glue
- Glue stick
- Filler for fob—walnut shells, leftover seed beads, or stuffing
- Parchment paper—the kind used for baking
- Sewing thread to match underlining
- Hand quilting thread to match linen
- Monoject #412 tool (syringe-type tool for application of glue), optional
- Cord maker—manual or battery-operated
- 2 Quick-Grip clamps
- 2 Wood craft boards—approximately 3 1/2” x 5 1/2”. **Note:** Wooden pieces are needed for clamping (pressing pieces together with Quick-Grip clamps). Craft stores like Michaels carry small pieces of wood that are used for a variety of crafts. These are perfect for clamping.
