Carolyn Standing Webb of Carolina House Designs has a degree in education but finds needlework much more rewarding to teach.

She grew up in a home where art was a part of everyday life and creativity was encouraged. An EGA member of our Wasatch, Salt Lake City Chapter, she has been a needlework designer and teacher for over twenty years, teaching on the local, regional and national levels.

She has a line of patterns available in retail stores. Several pieces of her work have been published in books and magazines and she has won a number of prizes for her needlework.

She has her Master Craftsman in Counted Thread. Her goal is to share with her students her love of needlework and to help them relax and enjoy it.

“Queen Catherine’s Book Cover, Bag, and Pyn Pillow” Carolyn Standing Webb

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Catherine Parr was a beautiful widow when King Henry VIII decided that she would be a perfect sixth wife. As you stitch your blackwork sweet bag and book, you will learn about the woman who was not only passionate, but also intelligent enough to survive Henry.

The three related project pieces are a tasseled, silk-lined bag with different historical designs on each side; a ribbon-tied, book-shaped box that fits inside the bag; and a pin cushion, known as a pyn pillow in the time of Henry and Catherine. The bag and the book-shaped box are stitched not only with the traditional black that gives blackwork its name, accented with gold and silver threads and paillettes, but also with red and green silk.

Join us for this three-day, intermediate-level class in Salt Lake City in April 2023. There will be enough time to perfect your double-running stitch and learn when blackwork can and cannot be reversible. We will explore several shading techniques that include different sizes of threads and how to add metal threads to your patterns. You will learn how to stitch more than two dozen blackwork patterns and how to vary them. We will work with various metal threads including gold wire, pearl purl, lizerine, and bright check.

The class includes materials, instructions, charts, and diagrams showing how to hand-finish your bag and book cover. The pyn pillow directions allow you to practice finishing before you tackle the bag and book. The class kit includes complete, illustrated instructions and all materials necessary to complete the project.

Students should bring standard stitching supplies, a second pair of scissors for cutting metal threads, and additional light and magnification, if desired.
