

A Love of Christmas - Supply List

- 28 count Cashel Linen - Cream - 10 X 20 inches

This will give an approximate 1 inch border on the sides and 2 inch border at the top and bottom of the fabric. Depending on the frame or hoop being used, you may wish for a larger border around the edge. A layout will be provided and templates with Lesson 1. If you decide to use a different count linen, the amount of fabric will be different. The stitch count for each piece will be provided in the welcome letter. If you decide to use another type of fabric, it must be suitable for Pulled Thread. Hardanger or Aida will not be suitable.

- DMC Pearl Cotton #8 - Ecu - 1 ball
- DMC Pearl Cotton #12 - Ecu - 1 ball
- DMC Floss - Ecu - for attaching beads
- DMC Diamant 3852 - 1 spool
- Gloriana 12 strand silk thread - 1 of each of the following: Avonlea Green, Elizabethan Green, and Cranberry
 - *DMC floss alternative: Cranberry - 814 or 815
 - Avonlea Green - 3345 or 3346
 - Elizabethan Green - 934 or 935
- Mill Hill Seed Beads - 2011 - 1 package.
- Ribbon - 1/8 inch - cream - 8 inch length - 2 pieces, 10 inch length - 1 piece
- Felt - Cream - a 9 X 12 inches piece for assembly, a 3 X 3-inch piece for the needle page
- Card Stock - White or Cream - 8.5 X 12 inches
- Light Weight Iron on Interfacing - 4 X 2.5 inches
- Fray Stop - you may wish to use a small brush for applying it to fabric during assembly of the pieces.
- Aleene's Glue - only a few drops will be needed during assembly.
- Hoop or Frame - you will want to use one for the Pulled Thread embroidery.
- Scissors
- Needles - Size 24 and 26. - Beading
