What is First Come, First Served Registration?

Upon successful payment of your seminar registration administrative fee, you will know immediately whether you are enrolled into a class. If your desired class is already full, you will have the opportunity to enroll yourself in a second-choice class – and, if desired, place yourself on a waitlist for the full class. If a spot opens in the waitlisted class, the next registrant on the class waitlist will be contacted via email about the opening. You will have a limited amount of time (as indicated in the email) to accept the change or remain in your original, alternate class. First-come, first-served registration will eliminate the current waiting period to receive your class assignments. If EGA cancels a class, the registrant will receive a full refund of the \$100 non-refundable administrative fee **if the class cancellation results in the registrant not attending any part of the seminar**. If a waitlisted registrant does not attend any part of seminar, they will receive a full refund of the \$100 non-refundable administrative fee. However, if the registrant cancels, the administrative fee would be forfeited.
