

EGA National Seminar 2025 Registration Reference Guide

This reference guide may be used to assist you with registering for the EGA National Seminar 2025 (hereafter "seminar"). Please note, the exact verbiage you see on your registration screens may be different from what is shown in this guide. However, the steps you will take will be the same.

1. Helpful hints:
 - a. If the field has a **red *** next to it, then it is a required field.
 - b. Be sure to scroll past the banner on each page to access content.
 - c. You are not registered until you press **Submit** on the final page!
 - d. Virtual class, mini-class, and Sampler U fees include the registration fee, kit fee, and any applicable postage.
2. Before you begin your registration, gather the following information:
 - a. A list of which class(es) you wish to take. You may find it helpful to use this handy guide that shows the days each class is offered. <https://egausa.org/app/uploads/2024/09/2025-Class-Calendar-at-a-Glance.pdf>
 - b. The email address you **check regularly** for all Seminar correspondence.
 - c. Your EGA member number. If you do not know your member number, it can be found on the cover of your *Needle Arts* magazine, on the EGA website after logging into the members only section select the "Profile" button on the upper right portion of the screen, or you may contact EGA headquarters for assistance (egahq@egausa.org).
3. To get started, press the **Register Now** link on the EGA Seminar Central 2025 website (<https://egausa.org/event/ega-national-seminar-2025/>) or the link in your email. (Note: The link will be on the website at noon ET on Tuesday, 9/10/24 and every EGA member with a valid email address will receive an email from headquarters with the link to register shortly after noon ET.)

Beginning with Seminar 2024, EGA changed to a first come, first served registration model! All registrants will immediately know if their desired class has space available. If the desired class is full, they will have the opportunity to place themselves on a waitlist. If a spot opens in the waitlisted class, the next person on the class waitlist will be contacted via email about the opening. That person will have a limited amount of time (as indicated in the email) to accept the change or remain in their original, alternate class. If the first person does not respond within the prescribed amount of time, the next person on the list will be notified and so on.

Please read this important information:

Add the assistant registrar's email address registrar2025@egausa.org to your contacts so that emails will come directly to your inbox. If you are on a waitlist, you only have a limited amount of time to respond before the next person on the waitlist gets notified of class openings. If emails from the registrar go to your junk/spam folder, you may not see it in time to change your registration. Other important information is also sent from this email address. Check your email settings to be sure that you are able to receive emails that are sent to everyone.

- If registering before March 1, 2025, only the \$125 Non-refundable fee will be collected. The outstanding registration balance MUST be paid in full by **Saturday, March 1, 2025**.
- FULL payment, including the \$125 USD non-refundable deposit and any applicable kit fees, is required for any registration made on or after March 1, 2025
 - Nonmembers will be charged an additional \$76 to register for classes (This fee does not apply to memberships completed or in process by **August 1, 2025 (two weeks before registration closing date)**).

 - Registration will close **August 15, 2025** at Noon Eastern Time.

IMPORTANT: After you have registered, if you find that you would like to make changes to your classes or optional items, please wait at least 24 hours for credit card charges to be processed before making class or other changes. For additional assistance, please contact the Seminar Assistant Registrar.

After you have completed your registration, you will receive a confirmation email with your confirmation number which is required should you need to return to your registration to add optional items or to make changes.
