The group provides education and support to active and emerging fiber artists within the membership of EGA and participates in EGA's annual Education Exhibit held at seminar. Many members enter the triennial EGA National Exhibit, *Through the Needle's Eye*, and participate in regional fiber art exhibits.

### The Annual Jurying Process- Required to become a member of Fiber Forum

Works by applicants and renewing members are juried each year by independent jurors on the basis of both aesthetic achievement and technical skills, resulting in a score for each piece. Each piece is judged on its own merits. An acceptable score means one is eligible to join or remain in Fiber Forum. Calls for submissions appear in *Needle Arts*, the magazine of the Embroiderers' Guild of America, Inc. and in the Fiber Forum newsletter. Forms are posted on the Fiber Forum page of the EGA website.

The annual jurying process has a deadline of March 15<sup>th</sup>. Up to two pieces can be submitted a year using forms on the EGA website. Original, non-teaching pieces are submitted with two digital photos and an artist statement. The images must be titled with the name of the piece and labeled as the 'full' or 'detail' view. Members must re-jury at least every three years. The entry fee per piece is \$30. Upon acceptance, the membership fee is \$60 for three years or \$25 annually.
