Rhodes Snowman

Supplies: About 2" x 2" fabric or canvas whatever count you want for snowman

White, black, orange, green floss or Kreinik

(I used 22 count Aida for small snowman and 18 count canvas for bigger one; Kreinik Ombre 3200 for head and body, a shiny Kreinik or Rainbow Gallery in black; scraps of floss for rest.)

Head—About 18" of thread. Come up at 1. Count up 8 threads/holes, move one to right and go down at 2. Continue following the numbers clockwise around the head.

Body—About 36" of thread. NOTE—1 is one thread/hole to right of Head 1 using the same holes as head. Come up at 1, count down 14 threads/holes and move one to left for 2. Continue as for Head.

Body can be outlined with same thread used to make snowman or left undone. I went from one corner to the next on smallest snowman but did not do it on bigger one.

Using black add eyes, mouth and buttons using French knots or straight stitches; straight stitches for hat and stick arms; orange French knot for nose, a scrap of any color thread for a scarf around his neck coming up in holes both sides of head and knotted.
