How to Improve Photos of your Needle Art

Do your photographs of your needle art disappoint you? Do you wonder how the photographs in the magazines and brochures show the artwork much more clearly? Are you interested in learning some simple tricks to improve your own photographs of your needle arts? This class will guide you through simple techniques and tricks for getting great photos of your needle art without investing in a professional studio. Although Jennifer will emphasize using smart phones, cameras will be included. The outcome will allow you to get more acquainted with your camera or phone and settings; practice shooting; and techniques for getting the good shots. Then learn a couple of items in editing the photographs using different tools to polish them to a fine finish.



Course Description

- 1. Advance PDF document that includes instructions, tips and what you need to prepare for the class will be sent out with Zoom invitation approximately one week in advance
- 2. The initial meeting will start at 11:00am Eastern via zoom with a slide-show lecture by Jennifer that will include demonstrations, description of proper technique and outcomes and include questions and answers.
- 3. The meeting/lecture is expected to take approximately one hour or more and we will break for practice and experimentation.
- 4. The meeting will reconvene at approximately 3:00pm to discuss results and more questiolons and answers
