Classes and Studio Time

Green Frog Scissor Fob with Clara Warschauer

The New England Region EGA is very excited to host International Traveling Teacher Clara Warschauer from London, UK as part of Region Day! Clara will be teaching her *Green Frog Scissor Fob*, a beginner-friendly workshop suitable for those new to goldwork or stumpwork techniques.

The engaging and interactive workshop covers every step of the process, from tracing the pattern to mastering the essential techniques needed to complete the project. While some basic embroidery experience is recommended, no prior knowledge of goldwork is required. By the end of the session, participants will have completed the scissors fob and developed the skills to explore similar projects independently.



Technique: Goldwork/stumpwork

Proficiency: Basic, some basic experience in embroidery would be beneficial

Kit Cost: \$100.00 (USD)

Design Area: 1.5 in x 1.5 in

Kit Contents:

- Gold super pearl purl, smooth purl light green, tough purl dark green, green check purl, bobbin of Madeira heavy metal gold thread, small spool green thread, small spool black sewing thread.
Beads: 4 mm black Beads (eyes), #11 multicolor beads (used with chipping).
- Needles: #10 Embroidery, #10 Milliners, beeswax.
- Lasso tool made from one #20 Chenille needle with 12 inches #8 Perle cotton thread.
- Frog pattern, tracing paper, green felt, black felt, pot of PVA glue, brush for glue, small bag of stuffing, wood stick, length of gold twist cord for using as ornament or scissor fob.

Student Provides: 8-inch hands-free embroidery hoop, clamp for two-handed stitching, goldwork embroidery scissors, embroidery scissors, a velvet board or soft surface to cut the metals, tweezers (optional).

Max # of students: 22

Butterfly Curio Box with Kris Andrews

Join Kris Andrews, a certified Japanese Embroidery instructor from Vermont who also teaches surface embroidery and mixed media, to learn new stumpwork techniques while stitching elements of the life of the Monarch butterfly.

During this one-day basic exploration students will get a foundation in four different types of padding to give dimension to their work. We will also work on detached motifs with printed butterfly wings, basic needle weaving with silken pearl, and handling gilt pearl purl.

Note: Pre-work is required (approximately 4 hours). A pre-work kit will be shipped to students to stitch the cross stitch frame. This creates places to put the design elements during class with minimal counting.

Technique: Surface embroidery on linen

Proficiency: Basic intermediate

Kit Cost: \$50.00

Design Area: 4" x 6"

Kit Contents:

- **Pre-work kit:** 28-ct linen and silk thread to cross stitch the frame of the box.
- **Class kit:** silk pearl, gilt pearl purl, soie d'alger, hand-dyed wool felt, preprinted butterfly fabric.

Student Provides: Hoop or frame for a 4" x 6" design, an additional smaller hoop (about 3"- 4"), scissors, a ruler, lighting and magnification as needed.

Max # of students: 22
