Exploring Color Relationships in Textiles

Embroidery Artist: Katherine Diuguid

April 26-May 1, 2026

Course Description: In this workshop, participants will explore how to analyze and utilize color relationships in their work. Each participant will be asked to bring:

- 1 skein of a thread color they love
- 1 skein of a thread color they hate
- a collection of threads in a range of colors that correspond to their piece/image (no specification on type or fiber)
- either a piece of their own that is in progress or an inspirational image to work from. This can be any piece



they are creating or an inspirational piece they would like to work from, but they should have a color-related question that corresponds with it. For example- This piece feels flat, why does it feel flat?, How do I increase the focus to this part of the composition?, Why is _____ getting lost in this piece?, I love the colors of this image, how do I translate them into fibers?, How do I make this piece feel _____ (insert emotion here)?, Why does this area look muddy?, etc.




We will discuss color relationships, and participants will identify the color relationships found in their piece or inspirational image. Participants will take one color from their piece/image and will explore a range of thread mixing and stitch color samples. Additional time can be used to either continue to develop a piece they have in progress or create a piece inspired by their image.

Course Format: 5 days

Each day will include appropriate demonstrations or color theory presentations with class discussion. Kat will meet individually with each participant once a day to discuss their specific project needs/questions/concerns/feedback.

Outcomes and Applications:

Participants will create a series of color samples specific to their personal project/image. These samples will help each participant to understand the color relationships present in their piece/image and





will encourage them to explore ways of pushing and refining the color in their pieces. By learning basic color relationship principles, participants will better understand how to approach and refine their use of color in their work.

Biography:

Katherine Duiguid is a studio artist specializing in hand embroidery, dressmaking and textiles. Her current work investigates color theory and color interactions within stitching, especially goldwork embroidery. She has taught embroidery and textile workshops both nationally and internationally. She held a tenure-track position at North Carolina State University until deciding to focus fully on her own studio embroidery. She has held numerous artist residencies and has had the opportunity to work on special projects in the UK and in Chicago. For additional information, see her website www.*KatherineDuiguid. com*.
