Materials

1 skein DMC® 6-Strand Embroidery Floss in each of:

- color A #961 Dusky Rose—Dark
- color B #962 Dusky Rose—Medium
- color C #151 Dusky Rose—Very Light
- color D #818 Baby Pink—Light
- color E #3052 Green Grey—Medium
- color F #3347 Yellow Green—Medium
- color G #3046 Yellow Beige—Medium
- color H #3012 Khaki Green—Medium
- color I #341 Blue Violet—Light

color K is not pictured)

- color J #B5200 Snow White
- color K #3756 Baby Blue—Ultra Very Light (to match the linen when stitching the piece together; note that

FABRIC

DMC® 28-count linen fabric in #312 Baby Blue, cut into the following pieces:

- 2 each (for top and bottom of base)— 6" x 8" (15cm x 20cm)
- 1 (for embroidered piece)—5" x 6" (13cm x 15cm)
- 1 (for snap strap)—1.5" x 6" (3.8cm x 15cm)

NEEDLES

 Size 7 embroidery/crewel (with 2 and 3 strands of floss) and size 8 (with 1 strand of floss)

OTHER

- 2 pieces of thin, acid-free cardboard, each cut to 3" x 5" (7.62cm x 12.7cm)
- 2 pieces of thin, lightweight fusible fleece, each cut to 3" x 5" (7.62cm x 12.7cm)
- 1 piece of thin, lightweight fusible fleece, cut to 2" x 5" (5.08cm x 12.7cm)
- Washable marker, pen, or pencil for marking the design
- 4" (10cm) embroidery hoop (optional)
- 1 small snap fastener
- Acid-free tape (optional for basting)
