October 2025 EGA Stitch-a-Long Sammy Scarecrow Designed by Helena Whyte, Pajarito Chapter





The scarecrow was embroidered on a 9 inch square of orange gingham using a 6 inch hoop using DMC floss in my stash. All stitches used 2 strands of floss. DMC numbers are given when available.

- 1. Backstitch the head with orange floss (947).
- 2. Outline the hat with chain stitch using straw-colored floss (3820).
- 3. Fill in the hat band with running stitch of brown floss (801). Highlight the hat edges with a cross stitch using yellow floss (726).
- 4. Backstitch the shirt and pockets using variegated blue floss.
- 5. Stitch the buttons with French knots using variegated blue floss.
- 6. Fill the pockets with hay using straight stitches of straw-colored floss (3820).
- 7. Outline the fence post with a stem stitch using brown floss (801).
- 8. Stem stitch the arms alternating straw-colored floss (3820), yellow floss (726), and light green.
- 9. Stem stitch the hay hair alternating straw-colored floss (3820), yellow floss (726), and light green.
- 10. Outline the crow on the hat using backstitch in black. The eye is a French knot. The tail is a straight stitch. The wing is a lazy daisy stitch.
- 11. Complete the scarecrow face with a running stitch smile in black (310). The eyes are blue sequins. The nose is a red sequin.
