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## Material List A Colonial Band Sampler

**Student Proficiency Level:** An intermediate to advanced level class. Student must be capable of following stitch diagrams and have had experience working on linen fabric.

**Stitch Count:** 48 stitches wide by 151 stitches high.

**Sampler Size:** 2.7-inches wide by 8.6-inches high.

**Fabric Used:** 36-count Linen, Cream Color, from Zweigart.

**Cut Fabric Size Is:** 9-inches wide by 16-inches high, allowing a 3-inch plus margin on all four sides for framing and/or hem stitching purposes.

**Threads:** DMC #s (9 total) Ecu, 221, 407, 420, 926, 3052, 3362, 3790 and #80 Special Dentelles (a tatting/crochet thread also available from Sullivan's Thread Company.) Only a small amount is needed of the #80. #12 Pearl Cotton could be substituted. The #80 is a bit finer thread.

**Kit Materials Include:** Linen fabric, 8 skeins of DMC threads, #80 Special Dentelles, #24 and #26 tapestry needles, charting, stitch diagrams with instruction sheets, photo, washing instructions, and a 2-page bibliography of sampler stitching

Please have a pencil, ruler, scissors, hoop or other holding device (if used) and extra lighting and magnification if needed in addition to the kitting supplies on hand for the start of our class.
