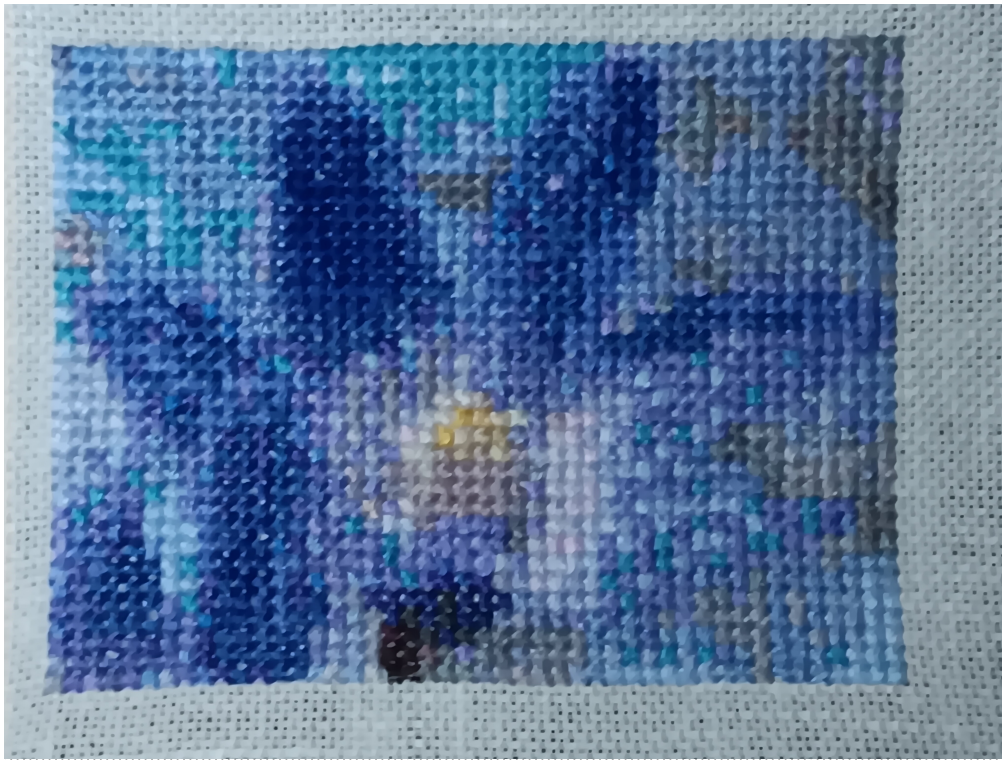


EGA Stitch-a-Long Project of the Month: August 2026

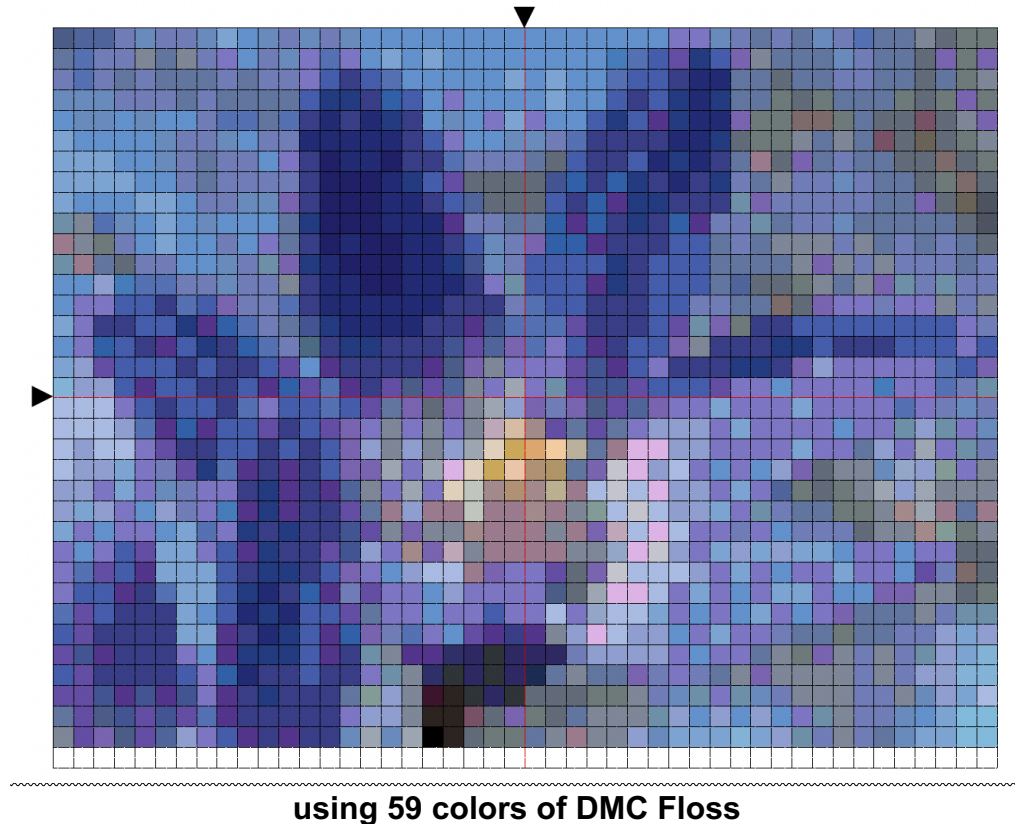
**If stitched on 14-count/28-count (over 2), this design will finish to about 3x3
And fit in a small frame**

Scilla section Chionodoxa, known as glory-of-the-snow, is a small group of bulbous perennial flowering plants in the family Asparagaceae, subfamily Scilloideae. Formerly treated as the separate genus Chionodoxa, they are now included in Scilla as a section. [Wikipedia](#)

This month's EGA Stitch-a-Long project is a full-coverage cross stitch flower. It is the Glory-of-the-Snow. Such a pretty name for a delicate flower. Enjoy stitching it! But what are YOU going to do with it once stitched? Here are some ideas: a luggage tag, an insert into a small purse that can hold your cell phone/wallet, a pin for a mom, grandmother, aunt, cousin, or friend (by adding a backstitched name in black on top of the flower!). What will you do with yours?

This lovely flower was photographed by my wonderful husband at his grandparent's home on Block Island, Rhode Island. I cropped the original photo down to a manageable size and ran it thru WinStitch17 to create this cross stitch design scaling it to a small size and telling the software to use 50 DMC floss colors. It turned this cropped photo (seen herein) into a watercolor effect presentation.

This is the color chart of how your piece will look.



Fabric:

This is a full coverage design. Use whatever count fabric and whatever color fabric you want, as you will cover the entire fabric if stitched as charted.

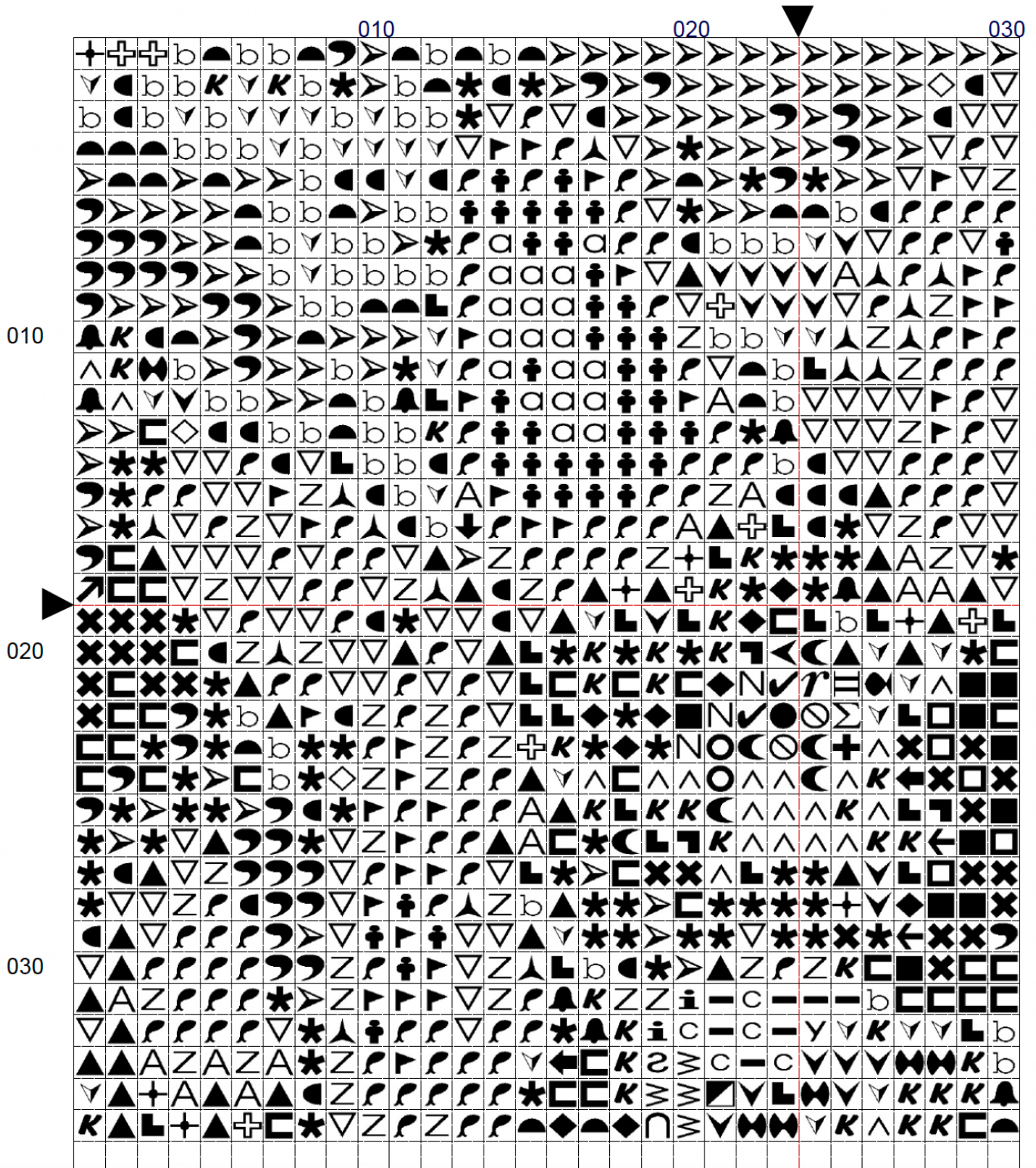
Design Size: 35 stitches high and 46 stitches wide

DMC Floss: Now the for list of colors: (Be prepared!):

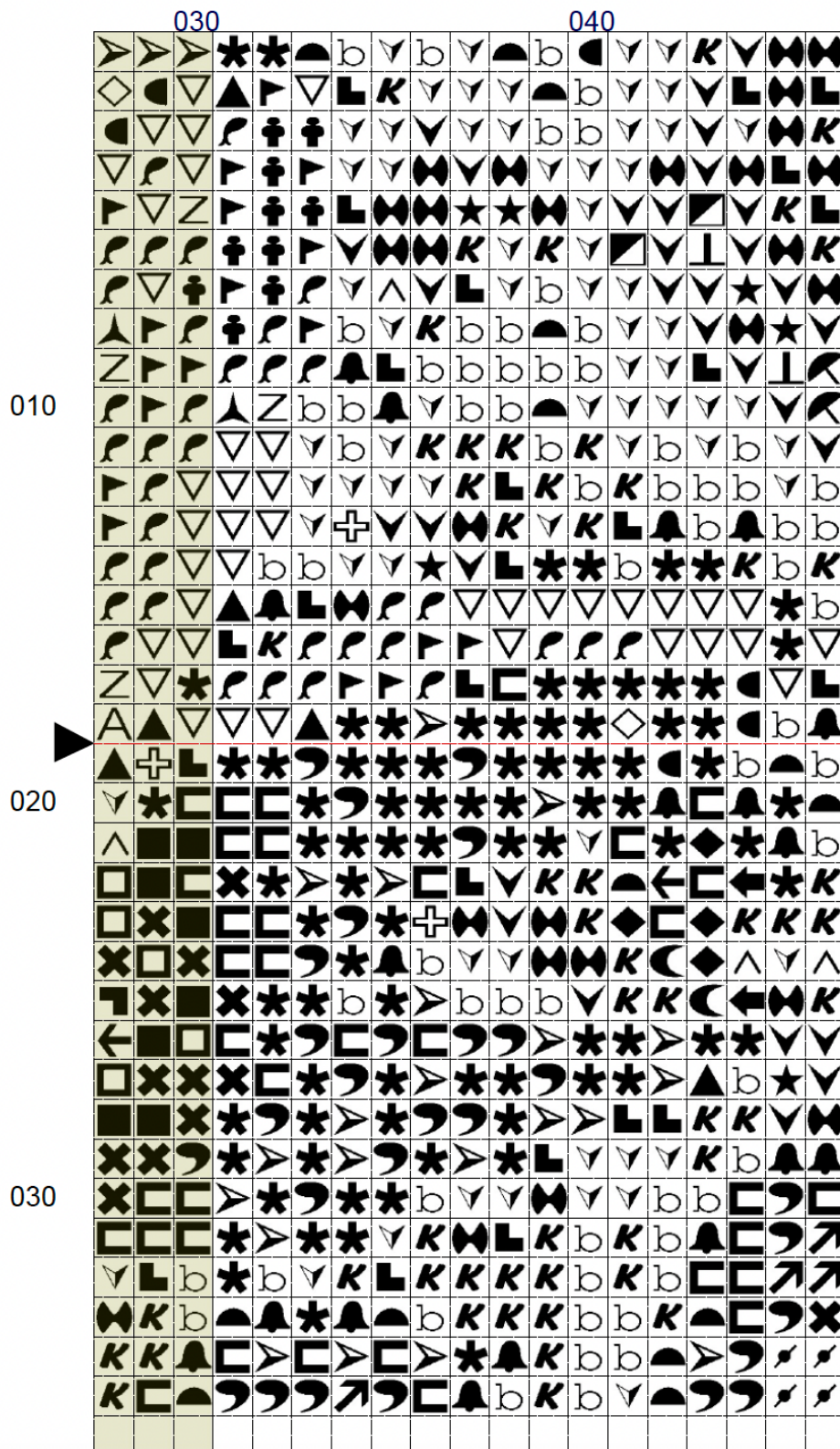
This is the list of **59** DMC colors needed for this design. It is truly a confetti design with many threads being used for only a handful of stitches. I have listed the DMC #'s here. If it has an * next to it, it is only used for 3 cross stitches or less. So if you don't have that color (or are losing your mind), you should easily be able to just use the color next to it on the graph instead of plugging in one lone cross stitch.

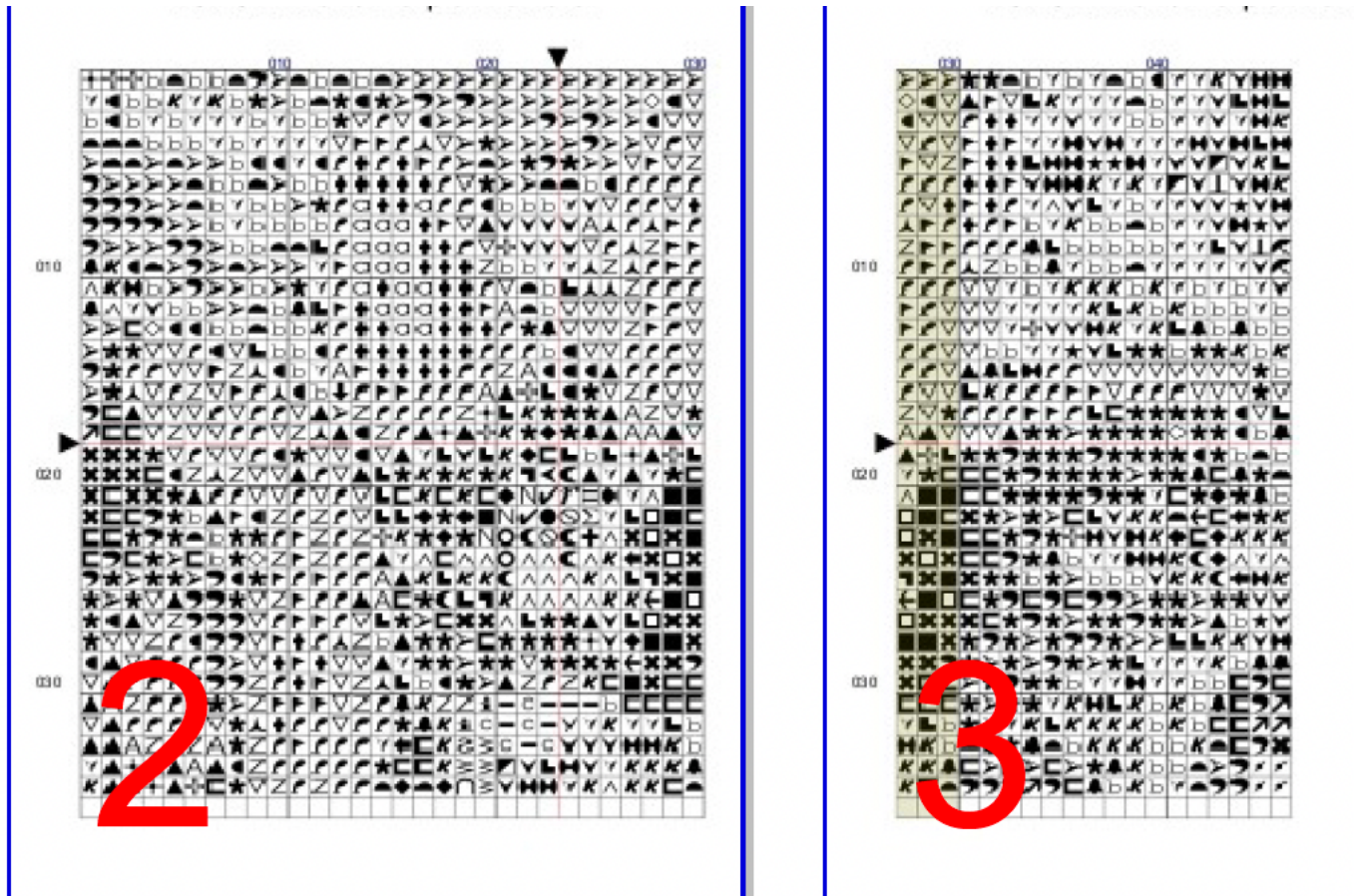

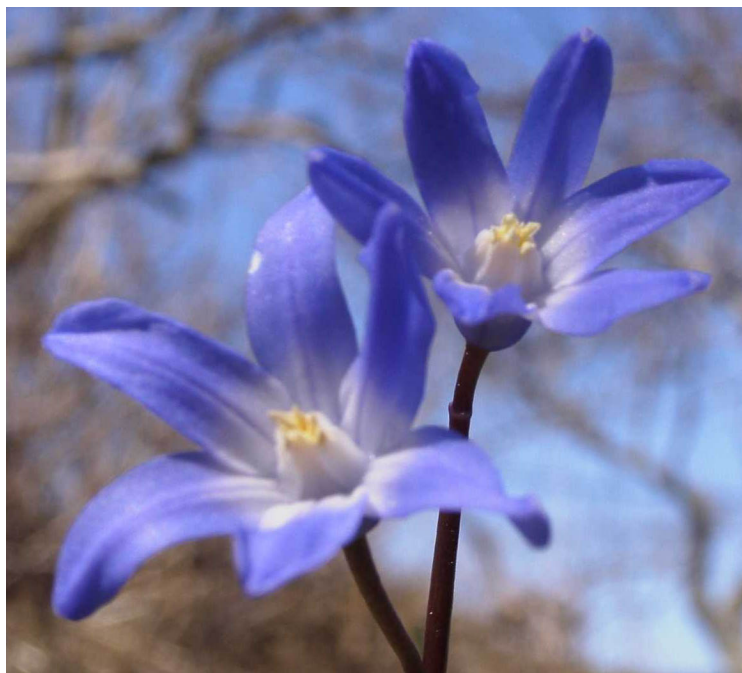
