



Cancellation Policy:

(1) Participant cancellation:

(a) The canceling participant must send cancellation notification in writing to the seminar assistant registrar at Registrar2021@egausa.org or mail to Sue Koehler, 11432 Balfour Drive, Fenton, MI, 48430, who forwards the information to the National Seminar Registrar.

(b) Cancellations received via email or postmarked on or before:

i. 60 days (July 3, 2021) prior to the opening of seminar will receive a refund less the nonrefundable deposit.

ii. 30 to 59 days (July 4 to August 2, 2021) prior to the opening of seminar will incur a \$200.00 cancellation fee which includes the nonrefundable deposit.

iii. 0 to 29 days (August 3 to September 1, 2021) prior to the opening of seminar the national executive committee will review within 30 days of close of seminar.

- A full refund will be given in the event of the death of the registrant.
- A full refund, minus the nonrefundable deposit, will be given to a member who is in the military and not able to attend seminar due to reassignment.
- A full refund, minus the nonrefundable deposit, will be given in the event of the death of a member of the immediate family. Immediate family is defined as spouse, child, parent, parent-in-law, grandparent, grandchild, or sibling.
- A partial refund may be granted in the event of serious illness of the registrant or an immediate family member, or a natural disaster preventing the registrant's attendance. Consideration in determining the amount of the refund shall be given after the cost incurred by the seminar is determined.

(c) No refunds will be considered after 30 days (October 5, 2021) of close of seminar.

(2) In the event EGA cancels a class after students have been assigned and a student chooses not to attend seminar, the seminar fee less the nonrefundable deposit will be reimbursed. Any travel costs the student has incurred are solely the responsibility of the student.

(3) In the event EGA cancels national seminar, the registrants will receive a refund of the registration fee, which may include the non-refundable deposit based on a decision of the board of directors.

Facility Use Policy:

A one-time facilities use fee of \$250 applies to a non-participant or any person registering for two or more days of classes but not staying at the seminar hotel, or anyone staying at the hotel with a room rate other than the EGA negotiated rate, as their stay will not be considered part of the seminar room block, which contributes toward payment of event and classroom space. If there are exceptions necessary, they need to be approved by the NSC director.
